



Kindergarten Supply List

2026-2027

- 1 plastic hard pencil box (approximately 8x5x2 inches to fit all desk supplies)
- 4 boxes of Crayola Crayon 24 basic color crayons (please no boxes of larger sizes, these crayons need to fit in the student's pencil box.
- 2 blunt-end pair of scissors (1 for art pouch)
- * 3 copybooks from school store (these are only from the school store, no marble composition books please)
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 2 drawing pads (1 for Art class)
- 4 boxes of tissues
- 8 Elmer's glue sticks (purple, clear or white) no scented glue sticks (Do not label)
- 2 packs of markers (washable preferred) (1 for art pouch)
- 1 spiral bound 3" x 5" index cards or index cards on a ring
- 1 set of headphones for computer – no earbuds (5 Below usually sells them)
- 4 large packs of Clorox wipes
- 1 100 ct. pack of plastic forks
- 1 100 ct. pack of plastic spoons
- 1 bottle of sanitizer
- 1 pack of fine black expo dry erase markers
- 1 pack of flushable wipes
- 1 fabric zippered pencil pouch for Art
- 1 12 pack colored pencils
- 1 bottle of Elmer's glue
- 1 pack of erasers

Please label pencil cases, crayon boxes, scissors, and headphones

Why **CRAYOLA** ?

We ask for Crayola because they have the true colors when coloring. In the past, we have had children who brought in brands other than Crayola, and the children (as well as we) have had to guess the color since there was no color description on the label, and the crayon color itself was faint or slightly different. This can be confusing and make a big difference when the lesson directions ask them to use a specific color. Another example is when the students color their papers, some children are actually disappointed that their paper (or color) doesn't look as good or the same as their classmates. Crayola also makes a stronger crayon that does not break as easily. So please, we ask that you only *purchase the CRAYOLA brand*. You can find them easily at Wal-Mart, Staples, Office Depot, Target, large grocery store chains, pharmacy chains, and occasionally at the Dollar Stores.

We hope this is helpful in understanding why we request a particular brand of crayons. If you would like to donate more CRAYOLA than what we are asking, we would be most grateful. You would be surprised how quickly the crayons get used, or lost, or broken.
